



[The Truth About the Health Care Reform](#)

a.k.a. “Affordable Health Choices Act”

(Diverse facts relative to Senate and House versions at time of writing)

- Estimated to cost **\$1.7 Trillion** to insure just 16 million of estimated 46 million uninsured (1/3rd)
- Spends **\$106,250 per person** newly covered! A hefty and inefficient price!
- May **bankrupt** advanced medical facilities like the Mayo Clinic and Cleveland clinic.
- Assesses penalties (**Fines**) on families for not buying approved insurance.
- Will lead many **employers to drop employer based coverage**, increasing Govt. dependence
- Will begin **taxing your employer provided health benefits**.
- Allows **government to compete with private insurers** leading to expansion of government control up to and including the government as a single payer system.
- Single payer systems in other countries have led to **rationing of care, long lines, and waiting lists** for doctors **visits, prescriptions, and treatments**.

Our current system is not perfect. There are changes to be made, within a free market, to improve. Among these is tort reform so good doctors won't have to spend hundreds of thousands on malpractice insurance. Such options should be exhausted before sacrificing all that is good about our current system.
